## SME SAVITRI AGNIHOTRI SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. There shall be two scholarships called 'Smt. Savitri Agnihotri Scholarships' of the value of Rs.100/- p.m. Each payable out of the interest on the funds endowed by Shri. V.S Agnihotri, B-1/47, Janakpuri, New Delhi, for award to the needy and deserving students (one male and one female) whose parent's/husband's including his/her own income does not exceed to the first year degree courses in the Faculty of Technology.
- The scholarships shall be tenable for the duration of the course renewable yearly on the basis of satisfactory performance of the awardees.
- 3. No student shall be eligible for the award of the scholarship if he/she already holds a scholarship awarded by Delhi University or any other University or the Central Government or any State Government or a Private Body other than a freeship. In case a student who has been awarded this scholarship accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source, he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on this account.
- 4. If it should appear at any time during the tenure of the scholarship that the scholar has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been found guilty of gross misconduct or has been irregular in attendance, he/she shall, after due warning, in writing, be reported by the Principal, of his/her college to the Academic Council which may suspend or withdraw the scholarship.
- The scholarship shall be awarded by the Academic Council on the recommendation of a Selection Committee consisting of the following:-
  - 1. The Dean, Faculty of Technology- Chairman

2. The Dean, Faculty of Science

3. The Principal, Delhi College of Engineering

- Two other persons to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendations of the Dean, Faculty of Technology.
- Applications for the award of the scholarships in the prescribed form should reach the Registrar. Delhi University, Delhi-7, through the Principal of Delhi College of Engineering by the date mentioned in the notification issued by the Registrar in this behalf.
- 7. The payment of scholarship amount will be made to the scholar each month through the Principal, Delhi College of Engineering on presentation of a bill and a certificate to the effect that during the period covered in the bill, the scholar was not in receipt of any other scholarship or financial assistance from any other source.
- Any amount accruing from interest from the endowment not spent in any year shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.
- The donor will be informed of the names of awardees of scholarship every year during his life time.
  - The above scholarship has since been converted into one time book grant (SC(scholarship) meeting dated 28/9/07).

\*\* The value of the book grant be at the present accrued annual income on such endowment fund (SC(scholarship) meeting dated 27/1/04).
