"KUSUM AGGARWAL MEMORIAL MERIT SCHOLARSHIP"

1. There shall be a scholarship<sup>\*</sup> known as "KUSUM AGGARWAL MEMORIAL MERIT SCHOLARSHIP" to be awarded out of the annual income accruing from the interest of endowment of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand Only) endowed by Prof. S.P. Aggarwal, formerly of Department of Operational Research, University of Delhi to the University in the memory of his wife Mrs. Kusum Aggarwal.
- 2, The scholarship shall be of the value of Rs.250/-<sup>\*\*</sup> (Rupees Two Hundred and Fifty Only). The scholarship shall be ordinarily tenable for an Academic Year from 1 August of a year to July 31st of the of the next year.
3. The scholarship will be awarded to a student of M.A./M.Sc. Operational Research Part-II, who secures highest marks in the M.A./M.Sc. Operational Research Part-I. The student must have secured at least 60% marks in M.A./M.Sc. Operational Research Part-I and continue his/her studies in M.A./M.Sc. Operational Research Part-II.
4. In case two students obtain equal marks in M.A./M.Sc. Operational Research Part-I, the merit will be decided on the basis of the rank of the student in the admission list.
5. No student shall be eligible for the award of this scholarship if he/she already holds a scholarship awarded by the University of Delhi or any other University or the central government or any state government or private body other than freeship. In case any scholar accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance/salary from any other source, he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her or this account from the date he/she accepts the other scholarship/financial assistance.
6. In case the student getting the highest marks in M.A./M.Sc. Operational Research is unable to accept the scholarship, the same shall be awarded to the next student strictly by merit.
7. The scholarship shall be awarded by the Academic Council of the University of Delhi on the recommendation of a Committee constituted as follows:
  - (a) The Dean, Faculty of Mathematical Sciences (Chairperson).
  - (b) The Head, Department of Operational Research.
  - (c) Prof. S.P. Aggarwal or his nominee.
8. If it appears at any time during the tenure of the award that the scholar has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been found guilty of gross misconduct or has been irregular in class, the scholarship may be suspended or withdrawn, on the recommendation of the Head of the Department, by the Committee constituted for the purpose.
9. The unutilized amount in any year shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.
